As the school closes for summer vacation, we have planned some meaningful activities for your child to enhance his/her learning skills in a fun filled way.


Few guide lines for you to make summer break fruitful:

**A. Make them independent:**

- Teach your child to write his/ her full name.
- Teach your child your name too (Father and Mother).
- Memorize phone number, house number and home address.
- Teach your child to do one household activity everyday.

**B. Life Skills :** Let your child learn to:

- Button up the shirt.

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- Pack up the school bag.
  - Keep toys back in their place.
  - Zip & unzip.
  - Tie shoe laces.
  - Open & close water bottle, lunch box.
  - Bathe independently.
  - Care for plants-water plants with spray bottles.
  - Know about ‘Good touch & Bad touch.’

### **C. Social Skills:**

- Spend quality time with your child. Take him/her to see places of interest. Click some pictures of the places you visit. Paste in the notebook.
- Play games like –Ludo, Carrom Board, Snakes & Ladder; building blocks etc.
- Play a memory game – Put a few things/objects in a tray, show the tray to things /objects which were on the tray. Try putting different objects.
- Learn to tell the time by the watch.
- **Green Drive** : (Plant a sapling): Explain to your child that plants also have life & discuss how do they grow & what is required for their growth.

#### Steps for germination:

- Take a pot
- Fill it with soil & manure
- Sow the seeds (seasonal plants/ flower).
- Water it daily & see it grow into a plant.

**Note: Kindly send the sapling to school after summer break. Click the pictures of your child for a while then cover the tray, ask your child to name /identify the **the child** while nurturing the plant & paste in the notebook (2 pictures atleast).**

### **D. Fine Motor Skills:**

- Let your child indulge in activities like mashing potatoes, rolling chapatties, clay moulding, shelling out peas etc.
- Mix a handful of Rajma & Chana. Ask your child to separate it using tweezers or with hands

**Note: Click photos (atleast two) & paste in the notebook**

**E. Outdoor Activities:** Kindly involve your child in the following suggested activities:

- Encourage your child to play outdoor games like throw & catch the ball, cricket, skipping etc.
- Gardening
- Playing on swings
- Yoga

**F. Art & Craft :** Suggested activities (Choose any one )

- Make any puppet of favourite cartoon character.
- Make a piece of jewellery like colourful beads necklace.
- Make Father's Day card or any Birthday card using waste materials.
- Make a model like clock, traffic lights or a globe.
- Make a mask of your favourite animal using paper plate/ paper bags , wool, buttons etc.

### English
