

MATHEMATICAL DEVELOPMENT

ORAL: Learn oral counting 1 to 50

- Help your child to draw the following shapes & paste pictures matching with the shapes – Circle, Square, Rectangle, Triangle, Star, and Semicircle.

MONEY MATTERS: Take a plastic ball, make a hole on the top of the ball, and keep a collection of loose coins. Help your child in storing and counting the coins to deposit and save in the created ball bank.

KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

- GREEN DRIVE: (Plant a sapling)

Explain to your child that plants also have life and discuss how they grow and what is required for the growth.

STEPS for germination:

- Take a pot fill it with soil and manure.
- Sow the seeds (seasonal plant/flower).
- Water it daily and see it grow in to a plant.

NOTE: Kindly send the sapling to school after summer break. Click the pictures of the child while nurturing the plant & paste in the scrap book (at least 2 pictures).

- Make anyone land transport using waste material like shoe box, old toy car tyres , bottle caps etc
- To develop knowledge about our five senses (touch, hear, smell, see, taste), click & paste your own sense organ in a scrapbook.
- Make flash cards of different body parts e.g. Face , Hands , Feet, legs , hand etc.

CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

FATHER'S DAY CARD:

- Help your child to make Father's day card using decorative material, colors/ paints etc.

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

- Spend quality time with your child. Play games like Ludo, Carrom board, snakes and ladders, scrabble etc.
- Have at least two meals together and ask them not to waste their food.
- Inculcate sharing habits, good manners, and respect in your child.
- Encourage your child to use magical words like please, sorry, thank you, excuse me, welcome, good morning and good night.
- Teach your child about personal hygiene.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Encourage your child to play outdoor games like throw and catch the ball, cricket, skipping rope and any other game of their choice.
- Encourage him / her to run, jump and play on the swings in the park.

LIFE SKILLS

- Make your child independent.

 2. Keep toys back in their place.
 3. Zipping and unzipping.
 4. Packing his/her school bag
 5. Tying his/her shoe lace.
 6. Open and close water bottle, lunch box.
 7. Caring for plants –water plants with spray bottles.

 9. Tell your child about "good touch and bad touch".
