4. Give revisions of oral syllabus, phonetics sounds, cvc words, sight words and general awareness questions attached with home assignment.
5. Craft activities involve cutting and pasting work and cannot be done without the use of scissors/glue. It is therefore advisable that children should undertake all craft activities under parental guidance.
6. Creativity of the child knows no boundaries; please feel free to experiment with new ideas/ways of doing things.

- Memorize your home address, phone number, date of birth and month.


#### BOOK: TALES AND TUNES

- Encourage your child to do picture reading and name different things found in the pictures.
- Using your own creative ideas, prepare an eye catching story book of 5-6 pages using A4 size sheets. You can decorate it with original grass, cotton, ribbons, coloured papers, colourful sand etc.
- Picture dictionary: Make a picture dictionary & paste 4 pictures related to each letter A-Z(In a booklet form)
- Letter collection :collect pictures of items that start with initial letter and sound of your wards name Paste your wards photograph in the center of the circle & the related pictures around it e.g;



**WRITTEN:**

- a) Write capital letters A-Z(2 times)on each page(Do 10 pages.)
- b) Write small letters a-z(2 times)on each page (Do 10 pages).
- c) Learn and write rhyming words done in the class (Do 5 pages).
- d) Learn and write sight words done in the class (Do 5 pages).
- e) Learn and write CVC words done in the class (Do 5 pages).

- ii. Thought of the day-child can learn any thought/quote with good moral value.
- iii. Prepare any hindi / English rhyme with gestures (not from the syllabus/book, for rhyme recitation competition. Rhyme should be child friendly.Write the rhyme in the school diary for selection.


## MATHEMATICAL DEVELOPMENT

### Oral

- Learn oral counting from 1 to 100.

### Written

- Write counting 1-100 (2 times) on each page (Do 10 pages).
- Number writing 1-20 (two times) on each page (Do 10 pages).
- Shapes – Revise the shapes done in the class - circle, square, triangle & rectangle. Make shape animal crafts & paste in the scrapbook e.g.



### Project

Make a calendar using coloured A4 size sheets with the name of the months, days of the week and numbers 1-30/31 according to each month.

## KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

GREEN DRIVE (Plant a sapling). Explain to your child that plants also have a life & discuss how do they grow & what is required for their growth.

### STEPS FOR GERMINATION:

- Take a pot-fill it with soil & manure.
- Sow the seeds (seasonal plant/flower). Water it daily & see it grow into a plant.

## CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

### TABLE MAT

Help your child to make a colourful table mat .

#### THINGS REQUIRED:

- A4 size sheet(Any colour)
- Crayons/water colour, cutouts/stickers of your child's favourite cartoon character/animal/fruit,glue.

#### METHOD

- Take one A4 sheet.Make a border on all the four sides of the sheet.help your child to draw/colour/paste on it.
- Write his/her name &class on the back side &laminate it.
- The child would carry this mat everyday to school.
