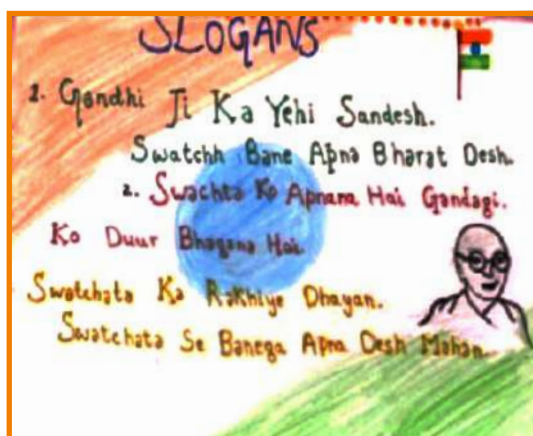


## Tribute to Teachers

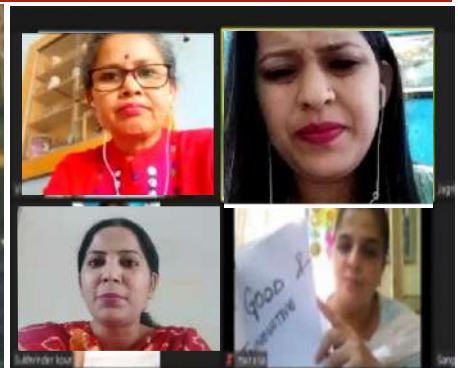

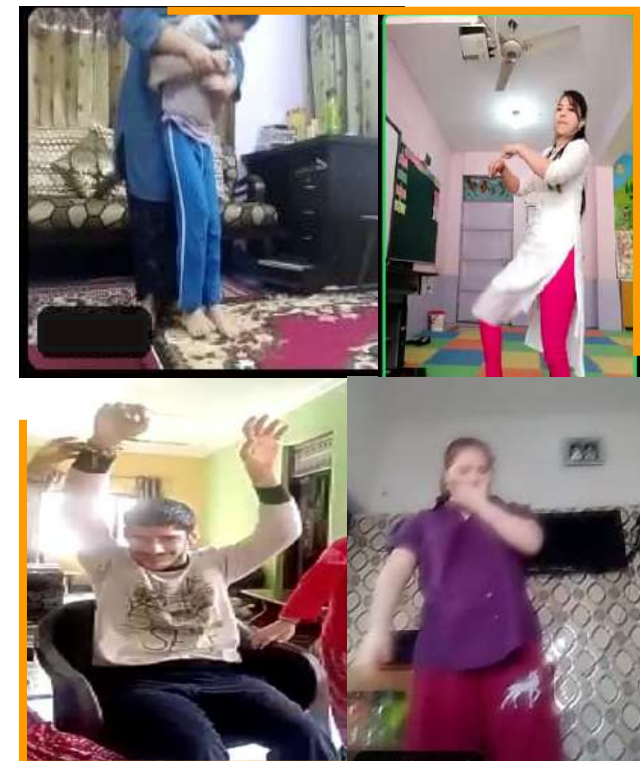

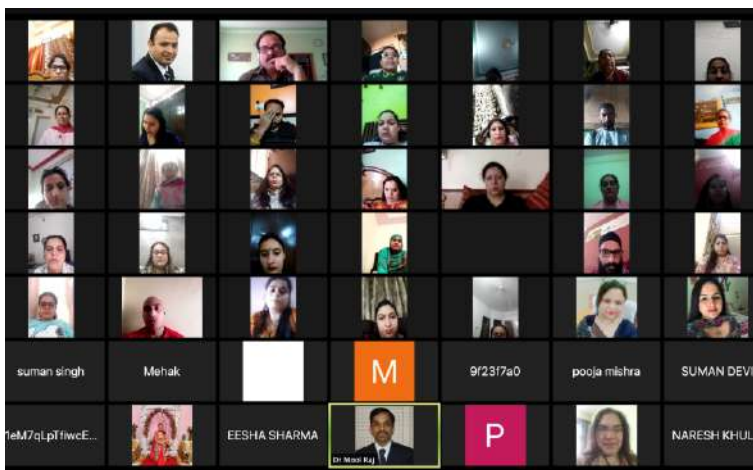

ICT Training and Workshops



The school in collaboration with the Centre of Technology of MIER College of Education organised numerous trainings and workshops to acquaint the faculty and students with the new digital learning tools and provided them the necessary support in shifting the entire teaching-learning process online during the lock down period for the smooth conduct of the teaching process . Trainings were provided in the usage of following software and apps :
