




Admissions Under Regular, Freeship and Inclusive Category



ADMISSIONS under Regular Category

Applications for admission in Classes 1st to 12th can be submitted from the month of February till April. There is direct admission for Classes 1st to 9th based on merit of the student in the previous class. However, admission to class 11th is made only after the declaration of Board result of Class 10th and students who have passed their class 10th with marks as per the criteria established by the school are given admission. For Classes 10th and 12th admissions are given to meritorious students only after seeking post facto approval from the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi.

Application form for registration is attached with the Handbook. The application form can also be downloaded from our website **www.modelacademy.in.** The application along with registration fee is to be sent as indicted in the form. **The registration fee is non-refundable.**

Once the admission is confirmed, deposition of school fees and other formalities need to be completed.

Admission under Freeship Category

In order to help students belonging to the weaker segments such as scheduled caste / scheduled tribe, below poverty line and students from RBA/LAC areas, the management is pleased to announce reservation up to 20% of seats under the freeship category in order to enable them to receive quality education. Admissions under this scheme are made by a committee constituted by the Director, School Education, Jammu as per agreement with the J&K Govt. Prescribed form for admission under this category are available from the office.

Inclusive Education



Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE)

The main aim of CCE is to evaluate every aspect of the child in the school. As a part of this system, students will be evaluated through a series of curricular and extra-curricular evaluations along with academics. The aim is to reduce the workload on students and to improve the overall skill and ability of the students by means of evaluation of other activities. Grades are awarded to students based on work experience skills, dexterity, innovation, steadiness, teamwork, public speaking, behavior, etc. to evaluate and present an overall measure of the student's ability. This helps the students who are not good in academics to show their talent in other fields such as arts, humanities, sports, music, athletics.

The Senior Secondary School Programme



The Senior School Curriculum aims to provide students with opportunities to grow and explore various higher education career options available for their self-fulfilment and training. The students are encouraged to acquire tools to deal with new technologies and to manage and accommodate change and develop moral, ethical and cultural values. The curriculum focuses on the requirements and capabilities of learners and aims at developing core competencies which a global 21st century citizen should possess. Besides the above subject combinations, General Studies and Work Education will be a part of the curriculum for all streams.

Class XI final examination is conducted internally by the school where as the Class XII board examinations are conducted externally by the CBSE. Number of papers, duration of examination and marks for each subject/paper are as specified in the curriculum by the CBSE. Marks/grades are awarded for individual subjects to the students.

Co-curricular Activities

The school provides an effective platform for students to pursue different hobbies and give boost to their creative talents. Various functions and events are organised to celebrate important days and festivals and ensure maximum participation in these events.

Educational Trips are organized on regular basis to give students exposure in different fields like leadership, team building, life skills, etc.

It is mandatory for the students to choose one hobby of their choice from the various activities like Karate/Judo, Vocal and Instrumental Music, Aerobics, Dance(Classical/Modern), Painting, Yoga, etc. which have been introduced by the school for the benefit of the students. The students are also assessed for their performance in the hobby of their choice and are given grades accordingly.

Sports Activities

Model Academy, an abode of holistic development, considers participation in sports as an essential component of academic pursuits. Therefore, a comprehensive programme has been created in order to provide an opportunity to the students for nurturing their physical, s o c i a l a n d personal development and to ensure development of various skills and competencies for playing different games and sports.

Extensive and impressive outdoor and indoor facilities for Basket Ball, Volley Ball, Badminton, Cricket, various athletic events, Table Tennis, Chess and Carrom are available in the school. Specialised coaches are employed to guide and train budding players and students are being encouraged to take active part in various events at state and national level. The school has also started a cricket academy at its campus.

House Activities

The purpose of the house system is to inculcate a sense of discipline and leadership amongst students and also to encourage participation of all students in every educational and co-curricular based programme.

The students are divided into four Houses viz:

Scouts and Guides Unit

The unit organizes various camps and activities like Pratham, Diwtya and Tritya Sopan for the students on regular basis. More than a 100 students have enrolled them selves in the scouts and guides programme of the school.

The unit also prepares students for Rajya and Rashtrapati Puraskar Tests. Many Students have won these coveted prizes on numerous occasions and brought laurels to themselves, their school and parents.

Scouts and Guides of the school also contribute in various social awareness programmes organised by the school.

NCC Naval Unit

The NCC Naval Unit of the school aims to develop qualities of Character, Leadership, Comradeship, Courage, and Discipline amongst the young cadets enrolled in the programme. The students develop a spirit of adventure, secular outlook and the ideals of selfless service by participating in a number of activities organised through NCC camps at various locations throughout the year.

The cadets learn boating, swimming, rigging, firing, ship modelling and about various means of communication at the camp. These cadets also perform various activities during the school functions.

Library Science Labs Smart Classrooms

Library

To introduce the students to the beautiful world of books and to inculcate good reading habits in the students, the school has three fully automated libraries one each for the primary/ middle wing, secondary wing and the senior secondary wing.

The school library is well stocked with over 7000 books that cover all academic subjects. Besides this, there are a number of storybooks, encyclopaedias, and General Knowledge books covering all genres. A reference section is also available for teachers and students. Computers and Internet connection have also been provided in the library.

These indispensable and constantly updated resource centres of knowledge make learning more enquiry based, effective and enriching.

Labs

The science labs in the school are well equipped with apparatus and chemicals and provide first-hand experience of all practical activities to each student.

These labs have a unique collection of charts, models, slides and specimens as per the syllabus of each class. By working in the labs students learn how to make a scientific argument, conducting experiments, reviewing them closely and developing logical reasoning.

25-30 students can be accommodated at a time in each lab. During the practical periods, each class is divided in to small groups for easy supervision. There are well- qualified lab assistants who help the teacher in demonstrating experiments and providing apparatus to the students.

Smart Classrooms

The school has Technology Enabled Classrooms equipped with Interactive Boards and Plasma TVs to make the day-to-day teaching learning process in the classroom more interactive, interesting and effective. These classrooms equipped with latest ICT tools help the students to comprehend difficult concepts, develop interest in various subjects, satisfy their curiosity and make the classroom learning environment more lively and fascinating.

The Smart Class programme is run through a knowledge centre which has a repository of over 35000 digital content in different subjects in the form of Presentations, Animations from Designmate, Videos from Britannica Encyclopedia and Discovery Channel etc.

Computer Labs

To enrich the students' learning process and make them tech savvy, there are two state of the art air conditioned Computer Laboratories in the school. They are equipped with computers and accessories in tune with the latest technologies and have a dedicated optical fiber based broadband Internet connection to cater to the educational needs of the students.

There are 40 computers in the two labs along with the latest licenced versions of the educational and computing software required for the students. Computers are used in combination with Interactive Whiteboards, LCD projectors for making teaching -learning process student centric.

Students also uses internet facility in the computer lab to browse information for their school projects and other educational activities.

English Language Lab

Model Academy is the first school in Jammu to have a Tablet based English language lab for improving the communication skills of its students.

The tablet-based solution by LIQVID, which is India's leading language skills development company, provides complete control in the hands of the teacher. The teachers are now able to provide individual attention to each student, and decides the pace of the lesson. Student's Tablets can connect to Teacher's Tablet wirelessly, enabling close teacher - student interaction in real time.

The language lab caters to the diverse population of students right from class 1st to class 12th and provides a large number of speaking / recording and video exercises. It would enable students to acquire correct language skills effectively.

Math Lab

The school Math Lab enables students to learn various mathematical concepts using over 1000 colourful collaborative activities and manipulatives.

The lab caters to the learning needs of students from class 1st to 10th and provides hands on experience for the students. Through visualization of math concepts in the lab the children relate to difficult concepts in mathematics more easily. This enhances their grasping capabilities and improves their memory.


Every topic has an assessment test to find out the level of understanding. Hundreds of interactive worksheets are available for practicing concepts that help develop high order thinking skills in the students. The content of the Math lab is aligned to topics as given in the school curriculum.





STUDENT SUPPORT





Counselling Cell

The Counselling Cell of the school organizes a number of career and vocational guidance activities for the benefit of the higher secondary students in a number of areas such as Engineering, Medicine, Armed Forces, Law, Hotel Management, Merchant Navy, Aviation and Tourism Industry etc. Various companies give presentations regarding different vocational avenues and interact with students in groups and on an individual basis.

The school has also created a database of various professional programmes being sought by the students.

Canteen

The school canteen provides a wide range of healthy and wholesome food at reasonable rates for the students and teachers. There is a well laid out seating arrangement for the students along with over the counter service for food items.

Transportation

School has its own fleet of buses plying on different routes fixed by the school authorities for the convenience of the students coming from many localities in and on the periphery of Jammu City. Parents are advised to check up with the office at the time of admission / registration /new session, regarding the availability of transport for his / her ward and charges thereof.

These facilities are being provided on yearly basis and no discontinuation in mid session is permissible.

Bank Facility

A full fledged branch of the Punjab National Bank functions in the school campus. This helps in providing all finance related facilities to both teachers and students. Special incentives are provided by the bank for students to open their accounts in the branch.

Dispensary

There is a well equipped dispensary in school manned by a registered medical practitioner that provides free First Aid treatment and also keeps track of students requiring follow up and reference to specialists. There is also a provision of Annual Medical Check up of all students. Besides this, doctors from various reputed hospitals keep visiting the school for various kinds of check-up of the students.

Reprographic Cell

The section provides printing, publishing facilities, scanning, photocopying, lamination and binding facilities to students and staff.

This Cell is equipped with the latest equipments and is geared for providing full DTP facilities to students and staff in line with modern trends.

Important Instructions

- Parents are expected to co-operate with school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline, by seeing that their children or wards prepare their lessons and by taking an active interest in the activities of the school.
- Parents are advised that entries in the admission form especially with respect to Name, Date of Birth, Parentage and Address shall be duly verified by them and certified to be true.
- Fees and other dues shall be paid by the 15th day of each month in school office. From 16th day of the month onwards, a late fee of Rs.50/- shall be charged for each month of delay or a part thereof.
- 4. No student will be allowed to sit for an examination if he/she has not cleared all school fees/arrears due to him/her before the start of that examination.
- Fees and other dues once paid are non-refundable, non-transferable and no claim will be entertained in this respect.
- 6. Students are expected to follow instructions as are notified from time to time. School authorities can impose fine, suspend a student and in serious cases, even rusticate or expel him/her from the school. Strict disciplinary action shall be taken against students who remain habitually absent or irregular or who do not appear in the examinations/tests conducted by the school from time to time. A student remaining on unauthorised

- absence shall be liable to be struck off the rolls of the school.
- 7. Entry of visitors is strictly regulated within the premises, and rights of entry for visitors including parents are reserved on the discretion of the authorities. Parents visiting the school are not permitted to disturb the classes by entering the classrooms and indulging in discussion with the students, teachers or other visitors in the institutional area.
- 8. Parents who would like to drop their children/wards at the school in the morning or collect them after the school hours, are requested to collect them at the main gate and not enter the school premises. They should also desist from parking their vehicles near the main gate to avoid over crowding.
- 9. Parents are strongly recommended to supervise the studies of their children at home. They should sign all reports and notes sent to them in order to ascertain that they have seen the remarks. They should attend all Parent Teacher Meets to know about the performance of their child.
- 10. Rules and Regulations provided in this booklet are not exhaustive and complete. Parents are advised in their own interest to keep themselves abreast with latest changes, modifications in rules and regulations related to the education of their wards in the school and go through the school

In a technology driven initiative the school has launched an online portal namely 'Campus Care' provided by **Entab**-a technology specialist company. This portal will enable parents and students to access data related to academic progress, examination results and financial information online and at any time of the day. Through the portal the parents can be in touch with the school administration and send messages to the teacher and the Principal regarding any aspect of their child's growth and development in the school.

GIRLS

Classes 1st to 10th

Beige shirt with white stripes - Half sleeves (Summer), Full sleeves (Winter), white collars, white flap on sleeves & school monogram on the pocket and Check skirt.

Classes 11th to 12th

Check shirt - Half sleeves (Summer), Full sleeves (Winter), bolero with school monogram, beige scarf with blue stripe and Beige full pant.

BOYS

Blue shirt with white stripes - Half sleeves (Summer), Full sleeves (Winter), white collars, white flap on sleeves & school monogram on the pocket. Beige half pant (for classes 1st to 5th) and Beige full pant (from class 6th onwards).

Accessories: Beige socks with blue stripes and black shoes, School belt, White ribbon and white band for girls and White (summer) and Blue(winter) patka for sikh students.

Sweater: Navy blue sweater with beige stripe on the neck (v-neck) with school monogram.

Blazer: Navy blue blazer with school monogram on the pocket.

Tuesday & Friday Uniform

On these two days students up to class 12th will wear their house uniform which consists of house coloured t-shirts, grey track pants, white socks and white sports shoes. For winter, they will wear track suits in their respective House colours.

Zero powered spectacles and white lab coats are compulsory for performing practical in classes X to XII.

Summer uniform will be worn from 1st April to 31st October and Winter uniform will be worn from 1st November to 31st March.




