Integrated Project Theme: "From Peaks to Plains – Exploring Diversity through Maps" Connecting Jammu & Kashmir and Gujarat through Geography & Culture

Objective:

To creatively explore how physical location shapes cultural diversity, using the knowledge of latitudes and longitudes and understanding social diversity and discrimination, through real-world examples from Jammu & Kashmir and Gujarat.

PART A: Travel Brochure Making (Creative Geography + Diversity Awareness)

Title: "A Journey Across Coordinates – "Jammu & Kashmir to Gujarat"

Task: Design a travel brochure (bi-fold or tri-fold) titled "From Gir to Gulmarg: Unity in Diversity", including the following:

- Locate and describe:
- The latitude and longitude of Srinagar and Ahmedabad.
- Climate differences based on location.



- Highlight cultural uniqueness:
- One traditional dish, one festival, and one art form from each state.
- Include a slogan promoting unity in diversity (e.g., "Different Roots, Shared Nation").
- Use hand-drawn elements or stick pictures (food, attire, festivals).

Tip: Make it colorful, creative, and informative like a real travel guide.

PART B: Chart Activity - "Mapping Diversity"

Title: "Jammu & Kashmir vs Gujarat – A Cultural Contrast on the Globe"

Task: Prepare a comparison chart on an A3 sheet with the following:

- Map of India marking both states and major cities.
- Latitude-longitude grid placement of each state capital.
- Cultural markers: Language, Dance, Music, Attire, Religion, etc. One example of how people from both states experience discrimination or bias, and how we can promote acceptance. **Use dual columns and lots of visuals.**

PART C: Reflection Journal (Civics Integration)

Topic: "I Am One with Many – Embracing India's Diversity"

Write a short diary entry (150–200 words) imagining you are a student from either Gujarat visiting Kashmir or vice versa.

Describe:

- What differences you noticed.
- How you felt welcomed (or not).
- What you learned about prejudice or acceptance.

Optional Add-ons (For Extra Stars!)

- Make a mini globe using a paper ball or cardboard and mark both states.
- Design a bookmark with your favorite quote on diversity (e.g., "Unity is strength, diversity is power.")
