For each, create a "scrap" page summarizing the work, noting its cultural significance, and identifying any common themes or narrative styles shared between the literatures of Gujarat and J&K.
- Research at least two iconic dishes or culinary traditions from each state. For each, create a "scrap" page describing the dish, its ingredients, and cultural context. Then, discuss how shared ingredients, cooking methods, or dietary preferences might connect or differentiate the cuisines of Gujarat and J&K.



Instructions:


Prepare a creative and informative project that showcases the unique and shared aspects of art and culture in Jammu & Kashmir and Gujarat. Choose any one of the following formats:

- 5. 3D Art Model or Diorama (e.g., traditional house models, cultural items)

Topics to Include:

- Visual Arts: Traditional paintings (e.g., Pahari/Miniature art of J&K and Warli/Rogan art of Gujarat) Textile and fabric arts (e.g., Pashmina shawls vs. Bandhani)
- 2. Performing Arts: Folk dances (e.g., Rouf of J&K and Garba of Gujarat)Music traditions and instruments
- 3. Handicrafts: Papier-mâché, walnut wood carving (J&K), Patola weaving, embroidery (Gujarat)
- 4. Festivals and Rituals



5. Cuisine and Food Art

Explore traditional food presentation, thalis, and art in culinary customs

6. Architecture

Compare historical monuments and traditional homes (e.g., houseboats in J&K, stepwells in Gujarat)
